



## Pattern Update PQD-182 Essentials Clutch

This update only applies to date code of 9/2012; updates have been made to patterns with date code of 1/2013 or later. Date code is located in lower left hand corner of Back Cover, beside the pattern number.

Every effort has been made to ensure that you receive an accurate pattern; when errors do occur, we will provide an update as soon as possible.

### Supply List Mini Clutch

Change from:  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard Lining Fabric

**Change to:**  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard Lining Fabric

### Page 1, Cutting Instructions for Bag using Yardage:

	Mini Clutch
Main Fabric	(2) 11" x 8" Outer Fronts
Trim Fabric	(1) 11" x 5 ½" Outer Bottom (5) 2½" x 11" Binding Strips

### Page 1, Step 4 should read:

4. Lay the Outer Bag over the Heat and Shape and **carefully cut to the exact size**. If you are making the Maxi Clutch, you will have to be frugal in cutting so that you have enough left over to make the mini clutch. Place the Outer Bag right at the top of your Heat and Shape piece. You will then have a large chunk on the bottom. Place your outer Mini on that and cut away the extra strip. Piece that extra strip to the end using a wide (4.0—5.0 mm) zigzag stitch. Just don't forget to remove your 1/4" foot and attach your utility or zigzag foot! Let's not waste a bit of Heat and Shape!

Clarification:

### Page 3, Finishing, Step 3:

1. Bind Side Seams from the bottom of the bag ~~to~~ **stopping at** the handle strip; there is no need to bind **inside** the handle strip (**it will be covered**).

Tip page 3, Finishing:

I use leftover fabric from the front fabric (cut to 2½" strips) to bind the side seams and top edge!

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
