

Swedish Woven Hearts - A Free Pattern by Poorhouse Quilt Designs!

- Cut (1) light and (1) dark half circle from pattern below
- Cut (4) 1 1/2" x 4" squares from light fabric
- Cut (5) 1 1/2" x 4" squares from dark fabric
- Cut one 1 1/2" x 6" strip from dark fabric
- Cut (1) 5" square of coordinating felt for backing

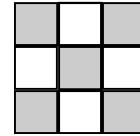
Sew together 9 patch block as follows:

- Sew together 2 strips consisting of dark-light-dark squares.
- Sew together 1 strip consisting of light-dark-light squares.
- Now sew the rows together alternating light and dark to create the 9 patch block.

You'll need 2 of these!



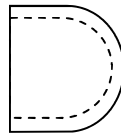
You'll need 1 of these!



Make an ornament hanger loop by folding the 1 1/2" x 6" strip in half lengthwise (wrong sides together) and press. Open out and fold raw edges to center and press. Press in half and topstitch this along

Final Assembly:

Sew along curves of half circle pieces, 1/4" from edge.



Sew one half circle to one side of nine patch as shown.

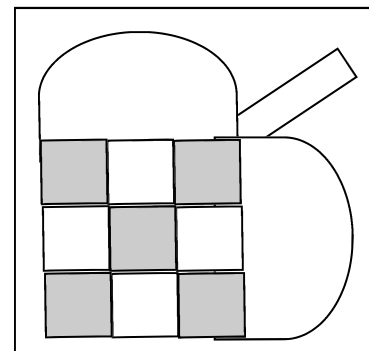
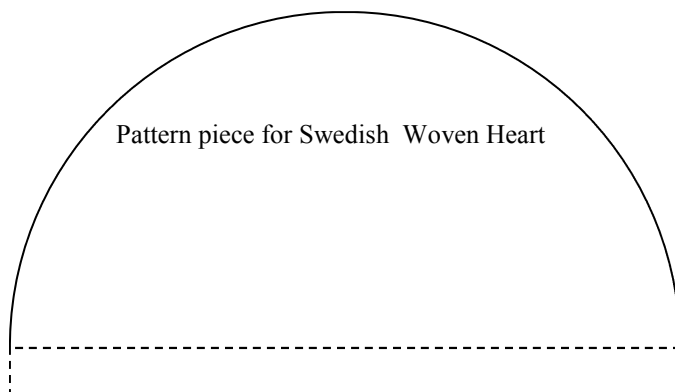
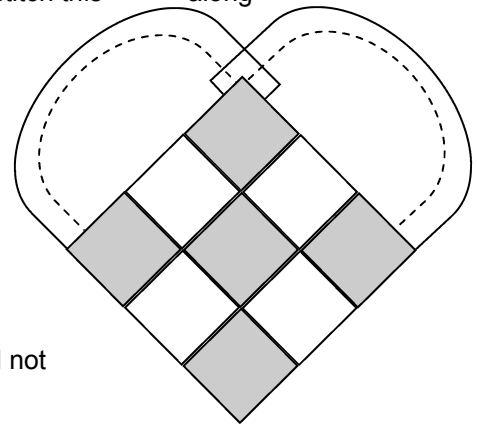
Press seam open.

Sew remaining half circle to the next edge to form a heart. Sew only up to (and not through) first half circle.

Press 1/4" all around heart. Use the stitching as a guide on the curved pieces.

Sew to 5" square of felt, placing loop folded in half between the felt and the pieced heart. I used a blanket stitch here.

Trim using pinking shears.
