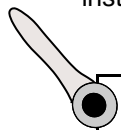


Week 3—(6) Block D and (6) Block E

The mystery continues....

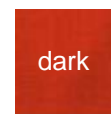
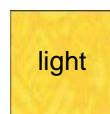
Again this week, there are 2 different blocks to make. A little more cutting than in Week 2, but still not too bad!

There are folks who have a scrappy background and folks who do not—for these 2 blocks, the cutting instructions are the same.



Cutting Requirements— Block B and C With SCRAPPY and Uniform Back- ground		
Fabric	Qty	Size
Background	12	4½" squares
	9	5" squares
Lights	6	5" squares
Mediums	6	4½" squares
Darks	3	5" squares

General Sewing Instructions:



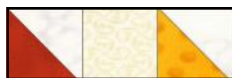
1. All seams are ¼" unless otherwise noted.
2. Chain piece when possible to save time.
3. Have fun!



Half -Square Triangle Units (HST Units)
HST Unit should measure 4½" square.

For Week 3:

Piece together (12) HST units using light fabric and (6) HST units using dark fabric - Follow instructions from Week 1 to make HST units.



Block D
Block D should measure 4 ½" x 12 ½" .

For Week 3:

(6) Block D

1. Sew a Dark HST to a Background square, then to a Light HST (Fig. 1). Press. Repeat to make 5 more blocks as shown. Make 6 Block D.

Block E
Block E should measure 4 ½" x 12 ½" .

For Week 3:

(6) Block E

1. Sew a Medium 4½" square to a Light HST and then to a 4½" Background square (Fig. 2). Press. Repeat to make 5 more blocks as shown. Make 6 Block E.
