Week 6 - THE BIG REVEAL! page 1

It's finally time to reveal the Mystery and put your quilt together -

Let's get sewing:

1. Group A: Sew Block D to Block E to Block A (Fig. 1), repeat for all 6 units.
2. Group G: Sew Block G Light to your Block G Medium (Fig. 2), repeat for all 4 units..
3. Now, lay your quilt out (the best part!!) Assemble each column, then sew together (Fig. 3).
4. Press.
5. The finished quilt center should measure 48 1/2" square.

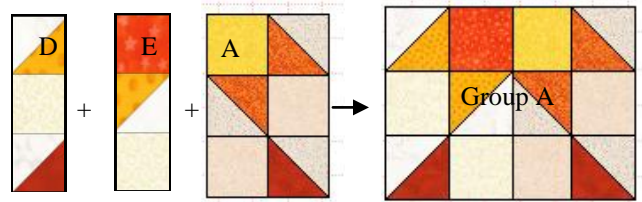

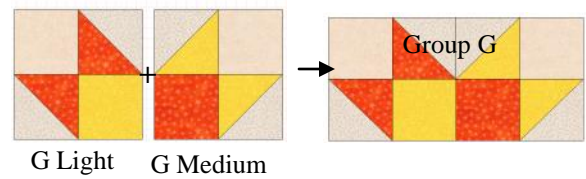

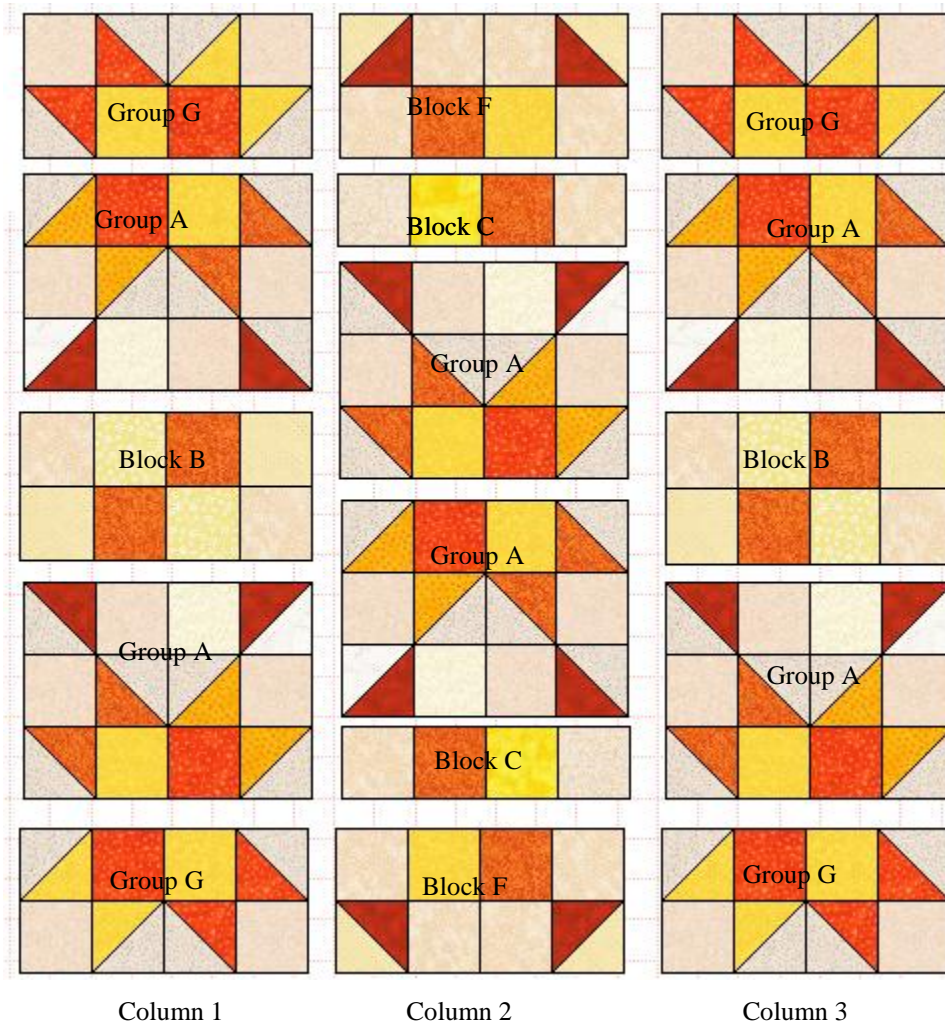

Week 6 - page 2

Now for a simple simple pieced border:

You will need 1/8 yard fabric for cornerstones, and 1/2 yard fabric for border strips and leftover background fabric (reference page 3 for a sketch of the quilt with borders on it).

- From border fabric, cut (8) 4½" x 24½" strips.
- From cornerstone fabric, cut (4) 4½" squares.
- From leftover Background, cut (8) 4½" squares.

Stitch:

1. Align background square to **one end** of 4½" x 24½" border strip (right sides together) (Fig. 4).
2. Sew across from corner to corner as shown below; cut off excess fabric as shown and press (Fig. 4, 5 and 6).
3. Make 4 total strips with triangles on the left and 4 more strips with triangles on the right (Fig.7).
4. Sew strips together to form a larger triangle in the center, using left triangle border strip and right triangle border strip (Fig.8). Press. Make 4 of these.

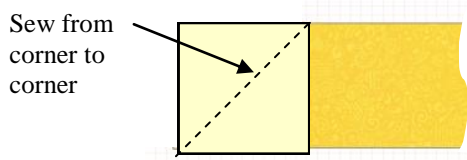

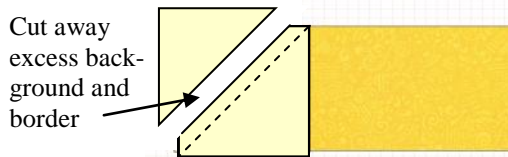

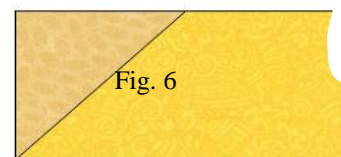

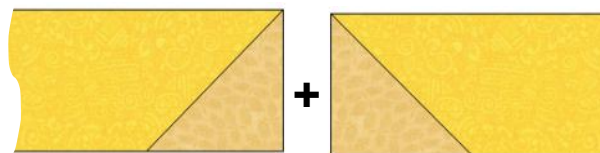

5. Sew 2 border strips to the sides of the quilt first.
6. Sew cornerstones to each end of the 2 remaining strips.
7. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

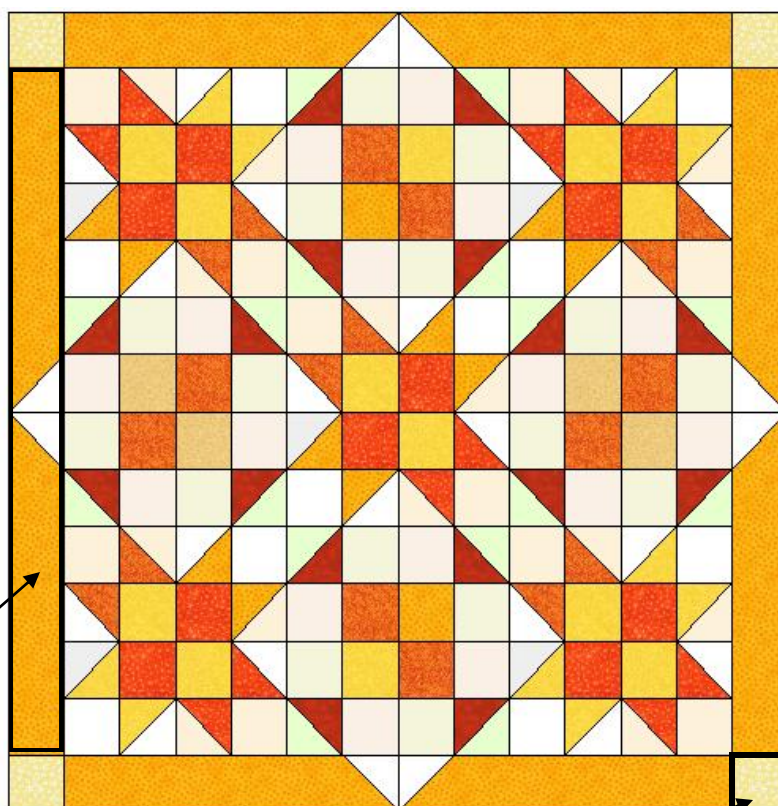
