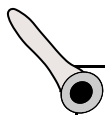


Week 2—(2) Block B and (2) Block C

The mystery continues....

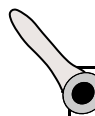
This week, there are 2 different blocks to make. They are easy—you'll be done in no time!

There are folks who have a scrappy background and folks who do not—from now on, there will be cutting tables to accommodate both.



Cutting Requirements— Block B and C With **SCRAPPY** Background

Fabric	Qty	Size
Background	12	4½" squares
Lights	6	4½" squares
Mediums	6	4½" squares



Cutting Requirements— Block B and C With **UNIFORM** Background

Fabric	Qty	Size
Background	4	4½" x 8½" strips
	4	4½" squares
Lights	6	4½" squares
Mediums	6	4½" squares

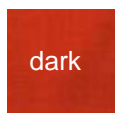
Fabric Key:

General Sewing Instructions:



1. All seams are ¼" unless otherwise noted.
2. Chain piece when possible to save time.
3. Have fun!



Block B

Block B should measure 8 ½" x 16 ½" .

For Week 2:
(2) Block B

1. Row 1 and 4: For a **SCRAPPY** background, sew (2) 4½" Squares from background together (Fig. 1). For a **UNIFORM** background, substitute a 4½" x 8½" strip from background. Press.
2. Row 2 and 3: Sew a 4½" Square from Light to a 4½" Square from Medium (Fig. 2), press.
3. Sew each row together as shown in Figure 3; make 2 Block B.

Block C

Block C should measure 4 ½" x 16 ½" .

For Week 2:
(2) Block C

1. Row 1: Sew a 4½" Background square to a 4½" Light square, then to a 4½" Medium square then end with a 4½" Background square (Fig. 4). Press. Repeat to make another block as shown. Make 2 Block C.
