Week 4—(2) Block F

Only 2 Blocks? Yes!

There are folks who have a scrappy background and folks who do not—for this block, there are 2 different sets of cutting instructions, use only one.

**Cutting Requirements—
Block F
With **SCRAPPY** Background**

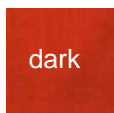
Fabric	Qty	Size
Background	8	4½" squares
	2	5" squares
Lights	2	4½" squares
Mediums	2	4½" squares
Darks	2	5" squares

OR

**Cutting Requirements—
Block F
With **UNIFORM** Background**

Fabric	Qty	Size
Background	2	4½" x 8½" strips
	4	4½" squares
	2	5" squares
Lights	2	4½" squares
Mediums	2	4½" squares
Darks	2	5" squares

Fabric Key:



General Sewing Instructions:

1. All seams are ¼" unless otherwise noted.
2. Chain piece when possible to save time.
3. Have fun!



Block F

Block F should measure 8 ½" x 16 ½" .

For Week 4:
(2) Block F

1. Row 1: Sew a 4½" Background square to a 4½" Light square, then to a 4½" Medium square then end with a 4½" Background square (Fig. 1). Press. Repeat to make another row as shown.
2. Sew (4) HST units using dark fabric (Fig. 2). Follow instructions given in Week 1.
3. Row 2: For a **SCRAPPY** background, sew (2) 4 ½" Squares from background together. For a **UNIFORM** background, substitute a 4½" x 8½" strip for the 2 squares from background. Sew HST units to either side of the background units (Fig. 3). Press.
4. Sew each row together as shown in Figure 4; make 2 Block F.

We'll proceed to the next step in 2 weeks!

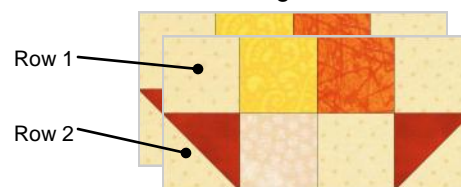
