



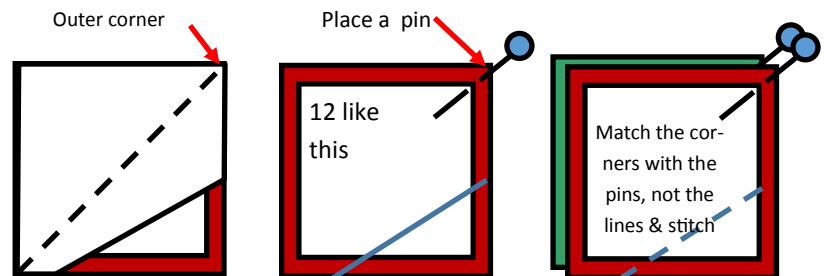
Poorhouse Quilt Designs presents:

Tips for the *Fold'n Stitch Wreath*

The Fold'n Stitch Wreath is a simple project - follow these tips for a faster finish!

1. FAQ: Are you looking for how to cut the applique fabric? The Prep steps are described in steps 1-3 - and there is a **video** to supplement these pattern steps here - <http://poorhousequilt.com/library/video-tutorials/>
2. Know which fabrics will appear where - look at Figure 1 on your pattern.
3. Using a directional print for the appliques? You may want to cut them at 45° and position design carefully during assembly.
4. Before turning your squares to the right side, trim the corners at a diagonal to reduce bulk.
5. FAQ: Step 12, do I have to match the lines, back to back?

Answer: No - you will match the Outer Corners. Place a pin at the outer corner and match the pins, back to back. Leave the pins in to continue to steps 13 through 14.



6. Use a walking foot or open-toe foot when appliqueing so you can see where you are going.
